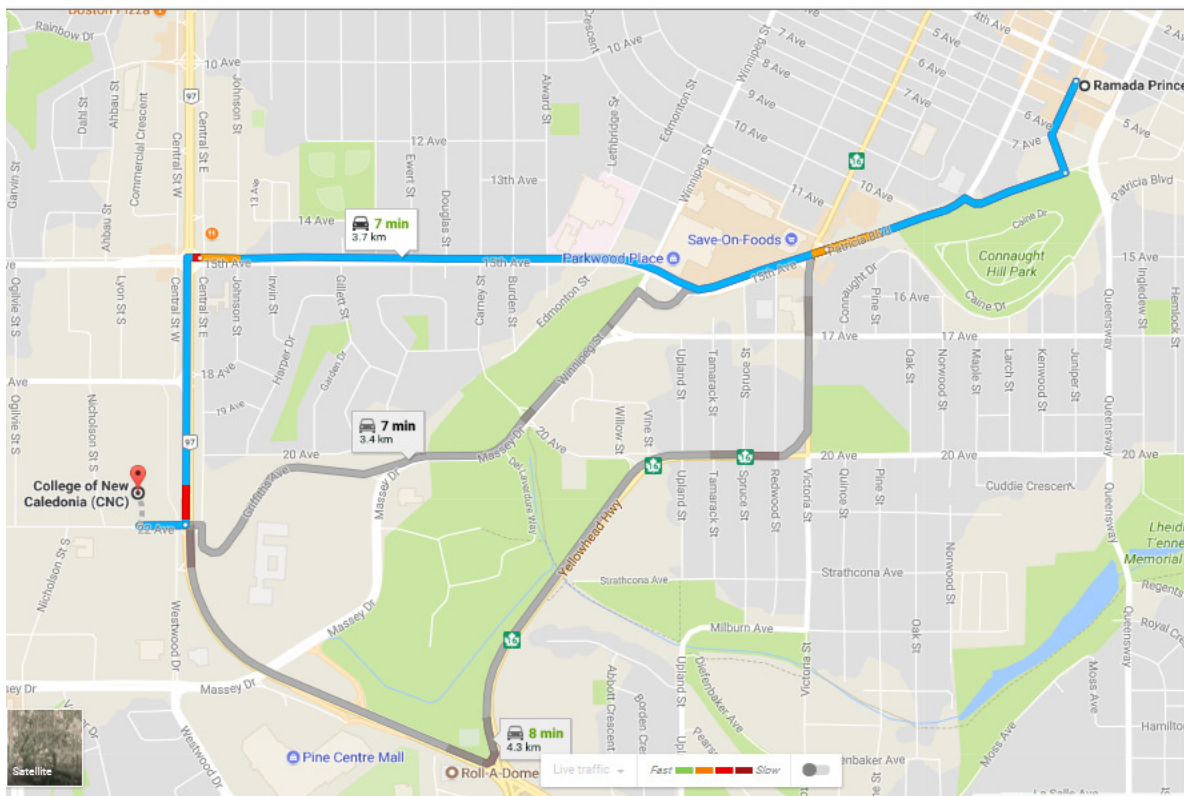

Directions to Emergency Reception Centre at CNC

An emergency reception centre has been set up in the gymnasium at the College of New Caledonia in Prince George, which is located at 3330 22 Avenue, along Highway 97 just north of the intersection with Highway 16.

Evacuees are requested to register at the reception centre. Assistance is available there with regards to additional centres (at high schools & university if/when opened), accommodation and lodging right on site, as well as emergency food and medical services.

Cariboo evacuees can also register with the Canadian Red Cross to access resources and assistance, as well as to enable family and friends to know the whereabouts of loved ones. Getting to CNC:

- Head southwest on George Street, veer left after 7th Ave
- Turn right onto Patricia Boulevard, turn left at stop sign.
- Continue along 15th Avenue
- Turn left onto HWY 97 (signs for Prince Rupert/Vancouver)
- Turn right onto 22nd Ave
